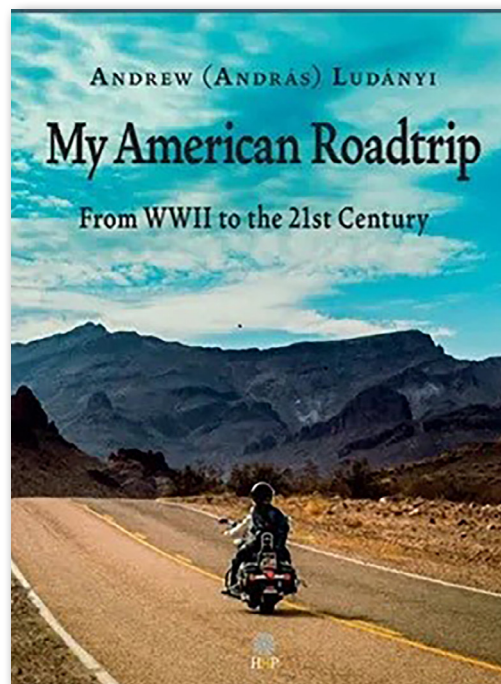


ANDREW (András) LUDÁNYI, **My American Road Trip: From WWII to the 21st Century**

András Ludányi (*Born in Szikszó, Hungary, in 1940*) is a Hungarian-American political scientist, sociologist, historian and university professor. In 1945 he fled with his family to Austria and later to the United States. He lived in Virginia and then in New York City, and did his university studies at Elmhurst University and Louisiana State University. From 1968 to 2008, he was a professor at Ohio Northern University. A founding member of the Hungarian Communion of Friends, the Hungarian American Coalition and the American Hungarian Educators Association, he is an active organizer and participant in Hungarian American public life. A Fulbright Hungary alum, Ludányi currently lives in Budapest and Ada, Ohio.
